We are going to **collectively** worship the Òrìşà Ọmọlú Burúkú that represents the manifestation of spiritual strength, regal energy, respect, magnificence, and sanctity. The Òrìşà Ọmọlú Burúkú works in sync with two energies - male and female, thereby assisting us in achieving wholeness, internal equilibrium, and harmony.

The annual ọdún is aimed at the replenishment of Àşẹ for worshippers, the community, and the environment as well as the provision and assistance for those who want to incorporate the qualities of this deity into their lives.

The introductory speech will be held by Bàbá King, the high priest of the Òrìşà Ọmọlú Burúkú. The offering will be followed by a ceremonial procession lead by those initiated into this Òrìşà as a way of honouring the Ọmọlú Burúkú energy and aiming to facilitate synchronisation with it.

The donation for the event is €40. Children of up to 12 years of age are our guests. With regards to families, one family member pays the full price while others registered at the same address pay €5 each.
