We are going to **collectively** worship a pair of Slovenian spiritual ancestors confirmed through the spiritual consultation with the divine wisdom of Ifá in June 2013. We asked *bàbáláwo* Awóḍiran for guidance in relation to our venerable ancestors because we wanted to use our knowledge on ancestral energies in this way as well. The need arose to dedicate ourselves to the worship of the past, and this is why we have been cyclically performing annual offerings for this purpose since 2013.

By worshipping the past, we affect the quality of our society's present and future. The representatives of venerable ancestors confirmed through spiritual orientation are the brave freedom fighter Stanka Varšek Lija and the general Rudolf Maister. Offerings aimed at honouring their memory and commemorating the National Day are going to be made.
